

X Shelves

How does the shelf system work?

Two shelf standards, each 38" long and 1 5/8" wide, are installed in a panel 14 1/2" apart (unless otherwise requested) and covered with fabric. Slots are then cut in the fabric so shelf brackets can be inserted. When setting up the display, simply insert the shelf brackets and position the shelves.

Are the shelves adjustable?

Yes. The shelves can be raised or lowered by changing the location of the brackets. The brackets are also adjustable so the angle of the shelf can be changed. The fabric shelf (item # PA120) is constructed of foam board covered in your choice of fabric. The laminated shelf (item #PA121) is laminated (black unless otherwise requested) 1/2" plywood.

Is there a standard shelf size?

Yes. Shelves are 20" wide by 11" deep unless otherwise requested.

How much weight will a shelf hold?

We recommend putting no more than 15 pounds on a single shelf.

XI Grommets

Are grommets available?

Yes. Grommets (PA132) and grommet holes (PA130) are available in any ExpoAire counter top.

What size are the grommets and grommet holes?

We drill grommet holes in the counter tops or panels and insert grommets. Our standard grommet size is 2 3/4". Please remember that the grommet (PA132) and the grommet hole (PA130 or PA131) are two separate items and must be ordered separately.

How do I specify where the grommet should be placed?

Mark the desired location on the Grommet Placement Form.

XII Back-lit areas in panels

Are cutouts available for back-lighting graphics?

Yes. Use item # PA136. The cutout should be at least 3" from all edges to maintain the panel's structural integrity. In a standard 23" x 46" panel, we recommend a cutout no wider than 17" and no taller than 40".

XIII Slatwall

How does the slatwall system work?

A section of slatwall is embedded in the panel. Instead of the standard fabric covered panel, the panel will have a wooden frame surrounding a 17" wide x 42" tall section of slatwall (other sizes available). The frame will be fabric covered to match the other panels, leaving the slatwall exposed. The back of the panel will be fabric covered as usual. Other than the exposed slatwall, the panel looks identical to a standard ExpoAire panel.

XIV Airelite Tabletop Displays

What is the AireLite?

AireLite is a smaller version of ExpoAire, designed for economical tabletop applications. Construction and materials are identical to ExpoAire.

What are the exact dimensions of the AireLite panels?

The panels are 40" tall. The width measurement depends on what part you measure. The panels are flat with beveled edges (where the panel meets the hinge) so there are three relevant width measurements; 18" of flat panel, 19" of total panel width (from tip to tip of beveled edges) and 20" from the center of a hinge to center of the next hinge.

Are shelves, slatwall and other customized options available with AireLite?

No
