How long has ExpoForm been offered?

ExpoForm was added to ExpoDisplays' line of products on March 1, 2002.

II System Construction

What materials are used in the construction of ExpoForm?

ExpoForm frames are constructed of extruded aluminum with cylindrical connectors. The rigid aluminum construction of ExpoForm creates a durable, structural framework designed to accept a range of infill panels.

What types of infill panels are available within the ExpoForm system?

Laminate, fabric, 4-color graphic, perforated metal, plexiglass (frosted & clear) and colored sintra panels are available

III Recommended Applications

How is ExpoForm most effectively used?

ExpoForm is a modular system that creates a strong yet lightweight framework for exhibit and retail displays. It works well to create dynamic inline displays as well as large custom structures. ExpoForm is a versatile rental option because ExpoForm panels are easy to assemble and reconfigure, and infill panels are easy to change out.

IV Panel Types, Sizes, Dimensions, Weights

What types of panels are available?

Flat panels and curved panels are available. Straight, cylindrical connectors are most commonly used to connect panels. Fixed angle and hinged angle connectors allow unlimited flexibility within ExpoForm design.

What is the maximum panel size?

The 39" x 95" flat panel, considered the standard building block of the ExpoForm system, is the largest ExpoForm panel available.

What do ExpoForm panels weigh?

The weights will vary depending on the infill panels selected.

Can Panels be customized?

Yes. Many options are available. Some of the more common options are:

- Door panels (locking)
- Graphic, plex, perforated metal
- Shelf standards, brackets
- Literature shelves
- Reinforced panels
- Plasma screen mounts
- Hanging Bars

V Fabric/Laminate Choices

What fabrics are available?

ExpoDisplays offers Foss (Premier and Regal) and Melded Fabrics (Front Runner, Prelude) fabrics.

What laminates are available?

There are virtually unlimited numbers of available laminates. When prices are quoted for laminate infill panels, they include "standard" laminates but not "specialty" laminates. "Standard" laminates include most solid colors and most wood grain finishes from Pionite, Wilsonart, Laminart, Nevamar, and Formica. "Specialty" laminates include textured, metal and faux finish laminates, plus laminates from manufacturers not listed above. It is always best to verify pricing on laminates **before** quoting.

VI Connection System

How are panels connected to create exhibits?

To make straight connections, panels are joined with straight, cylindrical connectors utilizing a collar and allen set screw. Fixed angle and hinged angle connectors are used to create angles. Panels can connect flush to create a seamless appearance or connectors can be used as spacers allowing the aluminum framework to become a design element.

VII Lighting and Accessories

What types of lights are available for ExpoForm?

A variety of halogen, incandescent and fluorescent flood lights, spot lights, and backlights are available. ExpoDisplays will recommend the best light for your specific needs and budget.
